Autumn Fete in Waikouaiti

More than 300 garden enthusiasts took the opportunity to visit the best English-style garden in East Otago on Saturday (March 17). They arrived from all over the region determined to make the most of the warm autumnal weather to ramble through the garden and enjoy the local artisan stalls. Many went home laden with plants from the Waikouaiti Garden Club's sales table, braids of garlic and locally produced preserves.

The Autumn Fete, held at Glebe Cottage in Waikouaiti, was a fundraiser for the \$1.4m redevelopment of the Waikouaiti Museum, which is being renamed the Waikouaiti Coast Heritage Centre.

A new exhibition building will be built immediately behind the historic bank building facing Main Road, which currently houses some of the Museum's more than 9000 exhibits.
